

<p>30th June Wednesday</p>	<p>AM: N/A PM: Group Assembles at Koryo Tours office in Beijing, transfer to Beijing airport. Flight from Beijing to Yanji (in North East China), transfer to city centre and check in Ryugyong Hotel (North Korean-owned hotel), free time in the evening, dinner at leisure OVERNIGHT: Ryugyong Hotel, Yanji (China)</p>
<p>1st July Thursday</p>	<p>AM: Drive from Yanji along the Tuman river to Wonjong Bridge border with DPRK Rason free trade zone, cross border into DPRK, lunch in Sonbong city restaurant PM: To Rajin city, city tour including Rajin Port, Kimjongilia hothouse, Central Square, and much more. Dinner in Rajin city OVERNIGHT: Namsan Hotel, Rajin (DPRK)</p>
<p>2nd July Friday</p>	<p>AM: Boat trip into the Korean East Sea (Sea of Japan) to see local wildlife, seals proliferate here, Pipha Island (local scenic spot), Rason Taehung Trading Corporation (rare chance to see some local industry – seafood of all kinds is processed for export here, a very large facility which also produces mushroom wine). Lunch at the trading company restaurant. PM: Relaxing at the beach, swimming, sunbathing, etc in this very popular spot for locals during summer, a rare bit of downtime on a DPRK tour! Picnic dinner on the beach (including clam barbeque) OVERNIGHT: Namsan Hotel, Rajin (DPRK)</p>
<p>3rd July Saturday</p>	<p>AM: Drive from Rason to Chongjin (3rd largest city in DPRK and almost never seen by foreigners, a real treat to be able to go here), lunch on arrival PM: Chongjin city tour - includes city square and statue of Kim Il Sung, Revolutionary Museum, Steelworks Kindergarten, Fisherman’s Club. Dinner at Chongjin Tourist Hotel OVERNIGHT: Tourist Hotel, Chongjin (DPRK)</p>
<p>4th July Sunday</p>	<p>AM: Drive to Mount Chilbo Area (very remote and stunning mountain range in the North East of DPRK, picturesque peaks and odd shaped rocks dot the area, a place seldom seen by outsiders even by DPRK standards. Stopping on the way at some local revolutionary sites. Lunch at restaurant in the mountains PM: Continue tour of Chilbo mountain area, stopping at most scenic spots, time for some brief walking in the mountains too before heading on to the beach below the peaks to visit and stay at the only place in DPRK where foreigners can stay in the houses of local Koreans, diner at the homestay village OVERNIGHT: Homestay Village, Mount Chilbo (DPRK)</p>
<p>5th July Monday</p>	<p>AM: Drive back towards Chongjin stopping at the Onpho spa for lunch PM: Spend some time enjoying the spa facilities in this famous (in DPRK at least!) location for natural spring and health treatments, once cured of all ailments continue on back to Rason area in time for dinner in the city OVERNIGHT: Rajin Hotel, Rajin (DPRK)</p>
<p>6th July Tuesday</p>	<p>AM: Walking tour of Sonbong city centre – the smaller of Rason’s twin cities, visit local school/kindergarten PM: Visit Rason ‘Comprehensive Service Centre’ for a chance to use the facilities (spa, sauna, ping pong, massage, etc along with the locals. Drive from Rason to Russian border to board train to cross the Tuman river to the Primorski Krai region, Cross border from DPRK into Russia by train, arrival at Khassan railway station (18:00) and meet local Russian guide, drive to Slavyanka village (2.5 hours), dinner in the village OVERNIGHT: Palada Hotel, Slavyanka Village (Russia)</p>
<p>7th July Wednesday</p>	<p>AM: Boat trip to marine reserve in the sea of Japan, see wildlife and stunning scenery, picnic lunch on an island in the reserve PM: Continue boat trip in the reserve, stopping at key sites, educational, entertaining, and a great way to experience a fascinating part of the Russian far east, return to Slavyanka in time for a free evening of exploring the village. OVERNIGHT: Palada Hotel, Slavyanka Village (Russia)</p>
<p>8th July Thursday</p>	<p>AM: Ferry to Vladivostok (2.5 hours), formerly closed to foreigners and the jewel of Russia’s far eastern area. City tour including heroic Submarine (sunk many U-Boats during WWII), local museum (next to birthplace of Yul Brynner), lunch at a local restaurant PM: Continue city tour with trips to Vladivostok Port, Funicular Railway for panoramic view of this most scenic of Russian, free time for wandering, visiting markets, anything you like, dinner at leisure. OVERNIGHT: Hotel Vladivostok, Vladivostok (Russia)</p>
<p>9th July Friday</p>	<p>AM: A whole free day to do whatever you please; see more of the city, relax in the hotel or at the beach, get some culture at a gallery or museum, or just people watch on the streets PM: The freedom continues! Afternoon and evening at leisure, try one of Vladivostok’s wide range of restaurant’s for dinner, nightlife options aplenty in this city too OVERNIGHT: Hotel Vladivostok, Vladivostok (Russia)</p>
